

PHD- 901 Diakonia, values and professional practice 10 ECTS

Work requirements, 2019

1. Participation/Attendance

Participants are required to attend 75% of the course. Valid absences must be documented.

2. Literature

It is expected that participants are familiar with relevant literature before the course starts.

3. Short paper and presentation

Persons that are full participants in the course are required to submit an abstract no longer than 300 words, summarizing the PhD project. During the course, we will have time for presentations by each participant and discussions related to the paper and presentation. It is expected for the student to hold a three minutes presentation, followed by questions and discussion relating it to the thematic of the course (aprox. 40 min pr. project). The presentation should be about your project with a focus on your preliminary ideas and/or questions regarding diaconia, values and professional practice. How do you consider the topics relevant to your project?

Supervisors can be invited to be present during the presentations and participate in the discussions.

4. Paper

To obtain 10 ECTS, the participants have to submit a paper after the course. The paper is supposed to be up to 10 pages (approximately 3000 words, 1, 5 line spacing) + bibliography. In this paper, it is expected that the theoretical foundation for the research course is discussed and reflected in connection with the participants' individual PhD projects.

The evaluation of the paper is based on the learning outcomes described in the Program

Description pp 11-12. Adequate academic standard in terms of references and bibliography is

expected.

Deadline for submission of written paper: 1th June 2019

Supervision: Participants are given up to 1 hour of supervision.

Course certificate: A course certificate is given when the coursework is successfully completed.
