Avoid using the download option, it will only grant you a single page. Select **“Save Pages”**:



Here you will have the option to send your current page and onwards. It is also possible to select **“This selection”**, meaning the current chapter that you’ve navigated to.

The number of pages you have available to save will vary from book to book.

After you have chosen the pages, select **«Save PDF»**. The excerpt will be downloaded, and it’s possible to both save and print.
